

IMPACT YOUR SUPPORT MADE POSSIBLE



School Health and Nutrition

In partnership with local health services and school officials, 134 schools in Saptari were outfitted with disinfectant, hand sanitizers and training that promoted important hygiene practices as they prepared to re-open.



Community Education

In partnership with local school officials and community members, 1,534 children between first grade and third grade attended reading and math camps in Sarlahi and Mahottari to help boost their learning after lockdowns.

Eleven-year-old Nibha was overwhelmed with excitement to start the 5th grade. Since she'd done so well on her 4th grade exams, her parents promised to buy her a brand-new red schoolbag.

Nibha has always worked hard, making top grades in all her classes, because she dreams of one day becoming a doctor.

All her excitement faded when her school closed because of COVID-19. Nibha didn't get the new schoolbag — in fact, she didn't get any new books to read. Nibha feared that she would forget everything she learned, and that she might never be able to go back to school.

But her hopes were soon rekindled. Through your sponsorship support,

Save the Children collaborated with over 200 local radio stations to broadcast educational programs to help children like Nibha continue to learn.

And Nibha is so grateful.

This is the kind of confidence-boosting, future-inspiring impact your sponsorship support is making in the lives of children in Nepal. Thank you for making change possible for so many girls and boys.



Adolescents' Development

213 local teens who were heavily impacted by COVID-19 participated in income generating activities to help support the livelihood of their families after job loss and prepare them to become responsible adults.



Early Childhood Education

To better empower families to interact and get involved with their children's education, 662 parents and caregivers were equipped and trained through "Building Brains" seminars that promote health, nutrition and safe learning spaces.
