IMPACT YOUR SUPPORT MADE POSSIBLE



School Health and Nutrition

15,156 children and teens received training and guidance to foster better health and nutrition practices through handwashing, disease prevention, dental care and regular medical check-ups.



Community Education

In partnership with local school, 827 teachers and educators enhanced their teaching abilities through training, workshops and peer support that helped them develop new teaching methods to foster greater literacy among their students.



NGUYEN WON'T LET COVID-19 STEAL HIS DREAM!

In the second half of 2021 Lao Cai province, where Nguyen lives, experienced a strong resurgence of COVID-19. Like many children in the area, Nguyen and his family were worried about how it would affect their lives and livelihood.

He couldn't study or play with his friends, and his parents couldn't work. It broke Nguyen's heart. He even feared his dream of becoming a soldier wouldn't ever be realized.

But Save the Children was there for Nguyen and his family providing resources that fostered at-home learning and education – and support that helped Nguyen's family get the resources they needed to survive.

Nguyen holds his head high in confidence and gratefulness. He knows he and his family are not alone.

Adolescents' Development

Local teen clubs attracted 3,197 teen girls to actively and openly discuss cares and concerns and receive guided awareness and support about gender, sex, teen pregnancy and reproductive health.



Early Childhood Development

1,357 local pre-school teachers in Lao Cai were able to enhance their teaching abilities with training, workshops and personal training in areas of early childhood literacy and mathematics to better support 16,860 children.
