

# IMPACT YOUR SUPPORT MADE POSSIBLE



### School Health and Nutrition

To prevent absenteeism and falling behind in learning due to malaria, 12 schoolteachers were equipped by local health care officials in malaria management and treatment to prevent any delays for medical treatment.



### Community Education

In partnership with local schools, the washrooms in 104 education centers, 64 schools and 10 community centers were upgraded to help improve the health and hygiene of children and community members.

Twenty-year-old Joyce lives with her mother and siblings. Her joy and infectious smile demonstrate how far she's come – and thankfulness for Save the Children and child sponsorship.

### Child Inclusion

With the support of community members, 5 local schools fitted washrooms and classrooms with ramps to help promote child inclusion. This action enabled children with special needs to attend and actively participate in learning.



### Early Childhood Development

5,592 parents and children were provided solar-powered radios and memory cards, along with school lessons, activities and school supplies to support learning and education growth at home for families in hard-to-reach areas.
