Community Health

13,000 children benefited from the construction of 6 bathrooms in 3 community schools. In addition, they received educational resources promoting the importance of hygiene, water and basic sanitation, and self-care.

Early Childhood Development

227 children benefited from the renovation of 6 local schools that included updating classrooms with desks and chairs, creating safe learning spaces for children and being outfitted with learning supplies.



Adolescents' Development

75 local schools supported teen girls through Girls Advisory Groups where they learned about sexual and reproductive health and received resources that promoted self-care and the prevention of sexually transmitted diseases and teen pregnancy.



Child Protection

372 parents or caregivers attended training sessions with 124 local school teachers to learn about child safety. The parents and caregivers were equipped to develop safe and nurturing learning environments at school and at home.

28,009 children under age 5 were vaccinated and protected against preventable diseases.



12,500 newborns and their mothers received prenatal and postnatal medical services and health treatments.



34,084 displaced children received school supplies so that they could continue learning in areas affected by conflict.
