Community Health

11,224 children and young people — including those facing disabilities — received critical health evaluations, medical care and referrals in 19 health facilities and 41 local schools.

Early Childhood Development

519 parents and caregivers participated in Early Childhood Development training programs to learn about effective teaching and nurturing strategies they can use to help prepare their children for school.



Adolescents' Development

1,075 teens in Sumba were guided and supported by counselors as they learned about and practiced problemsolving skills, implemented projects of change, obtained creative confidence and shared their stories.



Child Protection

1,917 parents, caregivers and local officials participated in forums that promoted the importance of child protection and gender inclusiveness in developing a nurturing learning environment in schools and at home. The forums also provided guidance on how to prevent abuse and exploitation.

2,008 children were given a forum to share their concerns and struggles in relation to child protection and safety.



43 fathers in 4 villages benefited from training that promoted healthy parenting of infants and young children.



12 new Early Childhood Education Centers were established in villages across East and West Sumba.
