School Health and Nutrition

319 children benefited from the installation and promotion in local schools of child-friendly spaces where they're able to have their mental and emotional needs met in a safe environment.

Community Education

5,202 children have more access to important reading and learning materials, as 5 community libraries were outfitted with new books, computers, fun educational games and furniture.



Community Health

927 children are being protected with the construction and refurbishment of 15 public bathrooms and wash stations, and with resources that promote handwashing and other important hygiene practices.



Community Engagement

438 children, parents and caregivers participated in 6 community-based forums that promoted child protection and safety and that equipped parents to foster a nurturing learning environment in the home.

632 Mayan-speaking children received books and learning materials in their native language to encourage their learning.
