School Health and Nutrition

2,318 parents and caregivers from 54 villages participated in Nutrition Week, where they learned about health, nutrition and personal hygiene — while also receiving nutritious foods and ingredients to help them at home.



Early Childhood Development

30 Early Childhood Centers received refurbished or reconstructed washing facilities and latrines along with hygiene training and soap-making classes meant to protect children from preventable diseases.



Community Education

3,796 children and 2,097 parents attended community reading clubs that promoted the importance of education and cultivating a safe and nurturing learning environment in the home.



Child Protection

600 adults and volunteers participated in child-safeguarding learning sessions that reinforced the principles of "positive parenting" and taught how to better provide inclusive education for their children.

2,745 children successfully completed social-emotional learning courses that taught them how to live with empathy and respect for others.



1,600 children from 40 villages participated in Catch-Up Clubs that helped them improve their overall literacy abilities.
