School Health and Nutrition

To ensure children were healthy and ready to learn, 48 local schools received hygiene and sanitation kits which included helpful resources about the importance of good health practices.



Early Childhood Education

240 local teachers were trained in child protection, the literary boost program and the principles of positive discipline. This will greatly enhance the education experience of 14,938 children.



Community Health

To identify and address vision and hearing problems among young people, a health screening campaign was organized that tested 563 students. Of these students, 133 had specific needs that were immediately treated.



Child Protection

To help protect children through the communities, 48 child protection committees were established involving over 450 individuals who are working to raise awareness about the importance of child protection — and promptly report cases.

More Important Results!

You made so much good possible last year. Here are a few more important results:



400 hygiene kits were given to mothers whose severely malnourished children were treated by local health professionals.



108 teachers received awareness training and resources to help recognize and prevent gender-based violence in local schools.



6,053 more students were able to continue learning in school after the installation of school cafeterias in 20 local schools.

Eleven-year-old Nisha in Nepal is no stranger to the devastating effects of climate change.
