IMPACT YOUR SUPPORT MADE POSSIBLE



School Health and Nutrition

714 children, parents and caregivers received training on health, nutrition and personal hygiene — raising awareness about healthy foods and providing proper care during times of illness.



Early Childhood Development

60 children under the age of 5 with disabilities received health and education assessments and programs were modified to give them equal access to education opportunities.



Adolescents' Development

812 young teens and their parents were given essential information about sexual and reproductive health to help prevent teen pregnancies and diseases and to prepare teens for a safe transition into adulthood.



Community Education

335 children in rural areas received increased access to alternative educational opportunities — ensuring school-aged children could continue learning despite living in remote areas.

1,384 children participated in Reading Camps that helped improve their writing skills and reading comprehension.



41 teens were assessed for continuing education, with 29 pursuing further training at a variety of local trade schools.



44 children participated in Child Rights and Resiliency training seminars that helped prepare them for further learning and development.

Eleven-year-old Nisha in Nepal is no stranger to the devastating effects of climate change.

Extreme heat followed by unseasonable rains spoiled her family's crops and diminished their only food source. Nisha and her family struggled tremendously.

"My parents had to buy expensive rice because our crops were destroyed. They were unable to provide necessary school supplies and a uniform for me. It is difficult to go to school without the proper uniform, pens and supplies for class."
