Community Education

46,048 children, including 11,655 children among ethnic minority groups, were reached with additional training and resources that will help them continue their education in the midst of conflict or natural disasters.



Early Childhood Development

2,290 parents or caregivers participated in Early Childhood Education training and received resources to help them create a safe and nurturing learning environment at home as they prepare their children for school.



Adolescents' Development

16,845 local teens participated in forums and conversations in 121 teen clubs, receiving support and guidance about their cares and concerns regarding gender, sex, teen pregnancy and reproductive health.



Child Safety

4,148 children participated in 10 student-led clubs and discussed the importance of child safety, child rights and inclusion — while learning how they can become more effective and respectful leaders in their communities.

5,000 teachers and educators received training and resources to help them more effectively teach following a child-safety model.



42 new “Learning Day” events were hosted that reached children and families and taught them the importance of learning together.



1,450 teens participated in leadership forums that helped them build their skills in planning, conflict solving and teamwork.
